The Vienna Taekwondo Open 2017 will take place on Saturday, October 14th, 2017. We will set up six to eight competition areas (depending on the number of competitors) and this year we will be utilizing the **DAEDO** electronic protectors for Kyorugi. Weigh-in will take place one day earlier, on Friday, October 13th, 2017 between 16.30 pm and 18.30 pm (**NO** weigh-in on Saturday possible).

The member clubs of the Vienna Taekwondo Federation cooperate in organizing this event like they did in the past years, aiming at organizing a successful tournament where all participants will be satisfied. Clubs interested in working with the Vienna taekwondo Federation in organizing this competition should send in their application per email not later than August 31st 2017.

This year's event will also be open to para athletes.

Vienna Open Poomsae Championships 2017

Vienna Open Poomsae Championships – A-Class (2nd kup and higher):

Age categories are based on the year of birth. For example, if someone is 30 years old on the day of Competition and he/she is still to become 31 years in 2017, then he/she will participate in the division 31 up to 40 years.

Pair competition: 2 athletes (m+f)

Team competition: 3 athletes (m+m+m / f+f+f)

A pair/team can be made up of two adjacent categories e.g two children, and one cadet; or one junior and 2 competitors up to 30 years. The compulsory forms will be those of the higher age category.

METHOD of COMPETITION: Cut off system

1st round (Preliminary; 11 or more contestants): Two Poomsae in accordance with drawing, the best 50% proceed to the next round. If the number of contestants is odd, then the number will be rounded to make even. (E.g. if there are 15 contestants in the category, then 8 contestants shall advance to the semi-final.)

2nd round (Semi-final; 6 to 10 contestants): Two Poomsae in accordance with drawing, the best 5 athletes qualify for the final.

3rd round (Final; 1 to 5 contestants): Two Poomsae in accordance with drawing.

COMPULSORY POOMSAE:

All Poomsae will be drawn by lot for each category out of the corresponding pool of compulsory poomsae. The forms have to be presented in the same order as they were drawn. The drawing of the poomsae will be performed by the competition board on the day of the competition, and will be announced immediately thereafter at the head of team meeting and hung up in the sport hall.

Vienna Rookie Poomsae Championships – B-Class (8th kup up to 3rd kup):

Age categories same as A-Class (see previous page), exception: the four oldest categories will be combined to one class in individual competition, i.e. **category over 41 years** (1973 and older)

METHOD of COMPETITION: Cut off system

1st round (Preliminary; 9 or more contestants): Two Poomsae according to choice from the given table, the best 50% proceed to the final round. If the number of contestants is odd, then the number will be rounded to make even. (E.g. if there are 11 contestants in the category, then 6 contestants shall advance to the next round).

2nd round (Final; 1 to 8 contestants): Two Poomsae according to choice from the given table.

8th and 7th kup: The two poomsae from the first round can be presented again during the final round

6th and 5th kup: One poomsae from the first round can be repeated

4th and 3rd kup: Repetition of poomsae from the first round is not allowed

Pair and Team Competition:

The choice of poomsae will be based on the lowest grade.

In B-Class (8th to 3rd kup), pairs and teams can be formed across the age groups, however the age class for the group will be based on the oldest participant.

In B-Class (8th to 3rd kup) in the team competition (3 participants), it is also possible to compose teams of both sexes (m+f).

Procedure in case of equal score:

a) In case there is a tied score after the completion of the preliminary round at the last place of the best 50%, respectively in A-Class on the 5th rank of the semi-final round, the higher points in presentation will be the determining factor for advancement to the next round. If this score is equal as well, all athletes in question will proceed.

b) In case there is a tied score after the completion of the final round on the rank 1, 2, or 3, the contestant who is awarded more points in presentation shall be declared the winner. In case the score is still tied, then the one who has higher total points (including highest and lowest points) shall be the winner. If it's still tied then a rematch between the contestants in question shall be conducted. In A-Class the referee will decide on the Poomsae to be performed (in any case one of the compulsory Poomsae), in B-Class the athletes are allowed to choose freely a poomsae from the given table (final round).

FREE STYLE:

Individual Male/Female separate : A, B class or less (1 group)

Age up to 17 years old, ≥ 18 years old

Pair 1 Male + 1 Female together : A, B class or less (1 group)

Age up to 17 years old, ≥ 18 years old

Team 3 Males or 3 Females together – not mixed : A, B class or less (1 group)

& Mixed team 2 Males + 3 Females or 3 Males + 2 Females : A, B class or less (1 group)

Age aged 12 years and older

Music min 60 – max 70 sec - **bring your music on CD or USB**

Obligatory: **Dwit kubi, Beom seogi, Hakdari soegi**

 Seniors (over 18 years; years of birth: 1999 and older)

Age categories are based on the **year of birth**. For example, if someone is 14 years old on the day of competition and he/she is still to become 15 years in 2015, then he/she will participate in the junior division.

 B-Class (Rookie Tournament): 8th kup up to 5th kup

Protection gear: All protector equipment must be WT-approved and be brought to the competition by the competitor himself (shin guard, forearm guard, groin guard, head protector, mouth piece, hand protector, DAEDO sensor socks). The electronic body protectors will be provided by the organizer.

Please note: **At this tournament the electronic DAEDO system will be used, the electronic sensor socks have to be provided by each competitor himself.**

Requirements for participation:

This tournament is open only for members of a WT-affiliated club or national team. Valid membership must be proved at the registration. All participants from an Austrian team must be in possession of a valid ID-card issued by the Austrian Taekwondo Federation (ÖTDV). Application and payment of entry fee has to be made in time.

All participants in the **Kyorugi competition** have to provide a proof that they have undergone a medical check during the last year and any participant who is under the age of 18 on the day of competition has to present a Declaration of Consent, signed by his or her legal guardian. **Without this Declaration of Consent it is not possible to participate in the Kyorugi competition!**

Duration of Contest: 2 rounds of 2 minutes each, 1 minute rest.

All participants have to wear the appropriate belt color according to their graduation. For the Kyorugi competition white dobok is mandatory, jacket with black neck only for black belts. In the Poomsae competition in addition to the traditional white dobok also the new JCALICU uniforms may be used (according the WT rules concerning graduation and gender).

ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES:

Visa:

Please note that if you need a visa to Austria this must be applied in very good time before the event. The organizers are not able to help with visa due to several examples of misuse of our trust in past years. Please contact the local Austrian Embassy or Consulate on all visa issues.

Awards:

Medals will be awarded for first to third place in each category.

Only those rankings that have been reached by winning at least one fight will be counted for the total ranking of teams.

Liability:

All participants of the Championship take part at their own risk. Under any circumstances the organizer cannot be held responsible for any damage, injury or loss to individuals or equipment. All participants agree with this by sending in their application.

Admission:

Admission for spectators at the sporting hall is free.

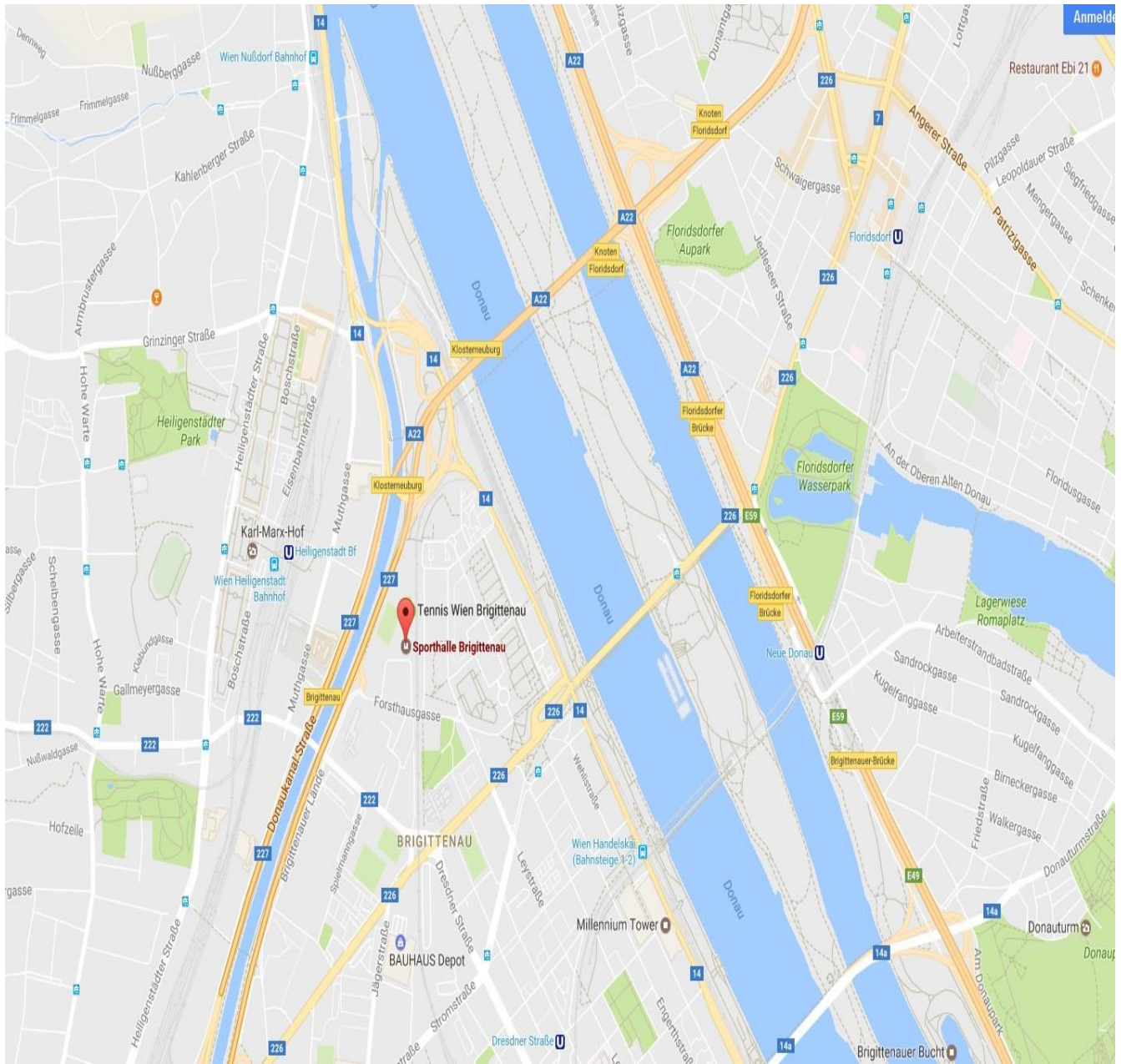
